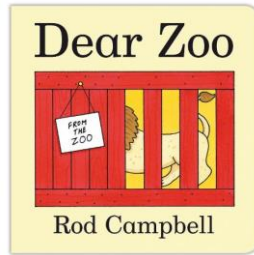


# Nursery Home Learning Week 2

## Phonics Challenge Aspect 2 – Instrumental Sounds

Can you make some shakers at home using empty bottles and different fillings such as rice, pasta or stones? Experiment with your shakers and talk about the different sounds you can hear. Can you move your shaker in different ways to change the sound it makes? You could try to match your shaker sounds to the different animals in the story. What would the elephant sound like when it is walking? What does the snake sound like?
