



Over the course of the year, we will have a number of opportunities to visit the Forest School. You will be informed of this in advance.










Home Reading

We adopt a library system which is completely run by the children.







Your child will have chosen a book from our UKS2 library or their classroom library. Each time they change their book, they will receive a new book sticker.

Children will be encouraged to change their book regularly which will mean reading regularly at home.

Children may read independently at home but it is still important to share stories or engage in book talk with your child. This may be asking them to summarise what has happened or taking turns reading sections of the story aloud.

Home Learning



Your child's learning in school and any home learning pages or tasks can be found on SeeSaw.





Children should practise spellings weekly on Spelling Shed. A list will also be provided in their Homework Diary. Spelling tests take place on a Friday.



Children will have a weekly target to reach on Reading Plus. They will have time to access this in school but may also need to complete some assignments at home.

Home Learning



Your child can also practise their maths skills and revisit maths lessons on Maths Shed.



Children can access Epic in school hours and this will be used as an additional reading resource.

Your child will receive their home learning books. They will go home on a Friday and should be returned on a Wednesday.

Medical Matters

- ► Inhalers: one to be kept in school.
- School can only give children medicine that has been prescribed by the doctor. This is to be taken to the main office and it will be kept in the fridge. It must be collected by a parent at the end of the school day. We can only administer medicine which has to be taken four times a day.
